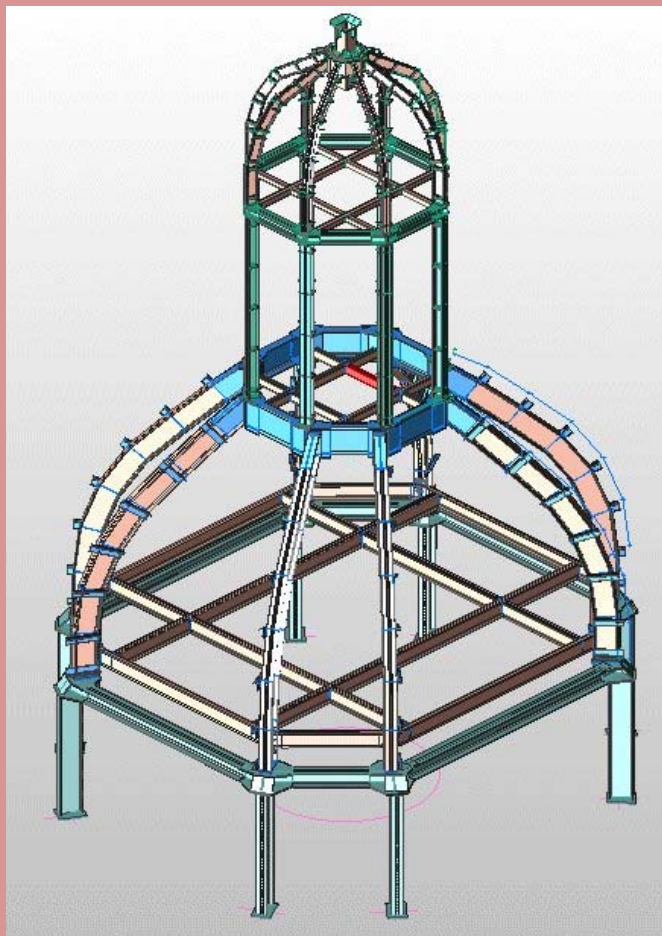

TECHNOMILLENNIUM 2010

Guidelines Participants:

1. Participants have to finalize their Project/Model title based on Industrial Assignments/ Technomillennium 2010 themes. Projects must be the original design and creation of the entrant(s). Subject matter is the choice of the participant(s).
2. In submitting a project, students agree that the project may be displayed at Technomillennium 2010.
3. Only first-, second-, third-place winners will be notified.
4. Students may work individually or in teams. The maximum number of students per team is **THREE**. For teams with members from different grade levels, the highest grade determines the entry category.
5. The student may combine multiple techniques.
6. The projects selected should be such so as to ensure the satisfaction of the urgent need to establish a direct link between education, national development and productivity and thus reduce the gap between the world of work and the world of study.
7. Design a project at adequate scale level for the following applications- It may be based (i) Entirely on study and analysis of a typical System, (ii) Experimental verification, or (iii) Design, fabrication, testing and calibration. The software based project can be considered based on its application for society development purpose.
8. Students are also expected to be scientific professionals. Risks to participants (animals or humans) should be minimized.
9. Unethical conduct may result in disqualification
10. The Participants are required to submit the 1page report based on project/model before participation as soft copy or hard copy to the tm2k10mit@gmail.com for consideration.
11. **The organizer will provide only the power supply extension board during the event. All other equipments like PC, display, speaker, etc has to be carried as per requirement by the students.**

Judging Criteria:

- Teams will be judge on the basis of scope of the project/Model.
- Judges decision shall be treated as final and binding on all

Team Specification:

- A team may consist of a maximum of 3 members.
- Students from different educational institutes can form a team.

Eligibility:

- All students with a valid identity card of their respective educational institutes are eligible to participate in the event.
- Students should carry their identity card at time of reporting.

Certificate Policy:

- Certificate of Excellence will be awarded to all winners.
- Certificates of Participation will be given to all the teams that will participate in the event, but not to the teams which get disqualified due to disobeying any of the competition rules.

Registration Fee:

- Limited Entries are available.
- Early Bird registration fee is Rs. 150 per student up 31st August 2010
- Regular Registration fee is Rs. 200 per student from 1st September to 15th September 2010.

Registration Procedure:

- Download registration form- at <http://www.mit.asia/Technomillennium3.aspx#Downloadable>
 - Print the form and fill the necessary information and take the bonafide certification from the head of your institute on the same filled hard copy registration form.
 - You can use the single form for the each team. Write the name of all team members on the same registration form.
 - There are two modes for paying registration fees. I) Cash and II) DD.
 - If paying Cash, contact at our contact address and issue proper cash Receipt and confirm your registration by submitting filled registration form.
 - If paying through a demand Draft (DD), issue a DD of amount equal to the registration fees needed for a team or individual from any nationalized bank in the favor of “**The Principal, MIT, Aurangabad**”, payable at **Maharashtra, Aurangabad**. Write your name & Name of competition on the back of DD.
 - Make the photocopy of DD and Filled registration form and keep this set for your reference. Send both the DD and Filled registration form (Both original) to the following contact address- (**Convener, Technomillennium 2010, MIT, Beed By Pass, Satara Village Road, Aurangabad, Maharashtra, India - 431028**).
